COVID-19 Cases in Our School Community

As you are all aware there has been two warn and inform letters posted to our website this week as we have had 2 COVID-19 cases close to our school community. However, no classes have had to shut or have been considered close contact. Please ensure that you continue to follow all social distancing measures while on the school grounds and wear a facemask at all times. Please ensure you do not send your child to school if they or any close family members show any one of the 3 COVID-19 symptoms (loss of taste and smell, a continuous cough or a temperature). British Legion Poppy Appeal

As we are currently unable to accept money into school, we will not be selling poppies this year. Instead our School Council have decided that we will all wear red to school on Wednesday 11th November as well as poppies. Children will also take part in making their own poppies in school. Children in Need

Our School Council have also decided that we will all wear pyjamas to school on Friday 13th November to raise money for Children in Need. Again, we would appreciate it if you could make a donation to Children in Need using the link which will be placed on our Facebook page next week.

Flu Nasal Spray

The school nurse will be visiting the school on Monday 16th November to administer the flu nasal spray. Please ensure you have completed the consent forms and sent them back to school in order for your child to receive it. Nursery children will need to be accompanied by a parent in order to receive the nasal spray. One parent will need to attend the school at 2 p.m. and will be asked to queue in the usual manner by the front gates, keeping a 2M distance from others. The nasal spray administration will take place in our outdoor Nursery canopy and parents will be asked to accompany their children one at a time. Once the nasal spray has been administered Nursery parents will be able to take their child home and will need to exit in the usual way past the office and KS2 entrance.

Christmas Concerts

We will be unable to conduct our Christmas concerts in the usual manner this year. However, we will be putting together a Christmas Concert for Dosbarth Hapus and Dosbarth Heulog and a separate Christmas Concert for Dosbarth Enfys, Dosbarth Draig and Dosbarth Seren. Children will be kept in their bubbles and will develop individual class items. This will again be developed into a video by our very talented video editor Mrs Lloyd and will be available to view on our Facebook page towards the end of December.
