Dear parents/ carers,

As all children have returned to school safely I would like to take this opportunity to highlight the current Welsh Government Restrictions for alert level 4. Although all children have returned to school, current restrictions outside of school will continue to remain in place. Outside of school it will be important that children and their families continue to stay at home and only travel within their local area as much as possible. It is also important to limit their children's contact with others.

The number of positive cases in RCT has dropped significantly which is thanks to the efforts of everyone. However, the cases have recently risen in Merthyr Tydfil and therefore I would like to strongly advise the following:

- Please continue to comply with the restrictions outside of school.
- Please avoid children's social contact with others outside of their family bubble. This includes **not going to other children's houses for tea or sleepovers as well as mixing bubbles in the local park.**
- When collecting children from school, parents will need to keep to 2M social distancing and wear face coverings on school grounds so that we keep everyone safe.
- It is also important that children are kept with parents/ carers when walking up the school drive to prevent our bubbles mixing.
- Only one adult should be taking children to and from school to minimise risks.
- Under no circumstances should learners attend schools/setting if they:
  1. Feel unwell and have any of the three identified COVID-19 symptoms (a new continuous cough, a high temperature or loss of taste or smell) or they have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 10 days. If children are presenting with any **one** of these symptoms, then they must go for a COVID test.
  2. Live in a household with someone who has symptoms of COVID-19 and they are awaiting a test result.
  3. Have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 10 days or are a close contact with someone who has tested positive.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you all again for your continued support.
